Our hiring process is simple: Find the best-qualified tutors who deliver content-rich lessons that effectively support students in achieving their academic goals. In the interest of transparency on your application journey, we've provided a brief summary of our required professional qualifications, general application guidelines and what we offer our awesome tutors.

Applicant / Tutor Minimum Qualifications

- 1. Tutors must be 18 years of age or older.
- 2. At the time of application and during employment with Virtual Tutors, applicants or tutors must have a minimum of two years education at an accredited US university and be enrolled in an undergraduate programme with the objective of completing a bachelor's degree.
- 3. Due to some state regulations, Virtual Tutors does not hire tutors residing or with permanent residency in the following US states: California, West Virginia, Massachusetts.
- 4. Tutors that wish to instruct undergraduate students must have a master's degree.
- 5. Tutors that wish to instruct graduate students must have a PhD.
- 6. Tutors that wish to instruct professional certification courses must be in possession of a current, valid US credential but are not required to have a masters or PhD.

Tutor Payment

- 1. All tutoring positions with Virtual Tutors are contractual only. We do not offer tutors benefits, Nor do we deduct any taxes from tutor earnings.
- 2. Tutors are paid on a bi-weekly basis per bank transfer.
- 3. Virtual Tutors does not offer tax advice to tutors. We recommend contacting appropriate tax advisors should a tutor seek information about tax law for contractors.
- 4. Tutors receive the following hourly rates in accordance with their education and / or professional qualifications and the subjects that they teach:
 - 1) Tutors enrolled in a four-year academic bachelor's degree programme with at least two years of completed fulltime academic enrollment:

- 5. Tutor rates apply only to the actual class time and do not apply to any class preparation or course materials.
 - Tutors may be considered for a 2 per cent raise in hourly rate after completing 100 hours of instruction.

- 1. Potential tutors must provide official identification documentation in their applications to be considered for hire. These documents include a US driver's license or ID card, US passport or US-issued residence permit and work permit. All identification documents must include a photograph of the applicant.
- 2. As independent contractors, tutors can teach a minimum of two hours weekly or as many hours weekly as they choose.
- 3. Tutors inactive for longer than one month will receive a notification to either deactivate their account or pursue at least two hours of weekly instruction within the following 14 weekdays.
- 4. All courses are virtual. Virtual Tutors does not offer in-person instruction.
- 5. All applicants are required to pass a federal background check with the assigned Virtual Tutors agency prior to final acceptance as a tutor.
- 6. Virtual Tutors does not provide curriculum, lesson plans or materials to tutors.
- 7. Tutors must have headphones, a computer and stable internet connection with a minimum of 8Mbps download and 2-3Mbps upload speed.

- 8. The application requires the applicant to submit video responses to specific questions. Any video responses without sound or images of the applicant will be automatically rejected.
- 9. All information submitted to Virtual Tutors remains confidential. Virtual Tutors does not sell any personal information to third parties.
